Introduction

This policy is to inform people about the use of the AABC logo for personal/ professional use.

AABC Logo

The AABC logo is to be used only by the AABC Register Ltd. The AABC accreditation is vested in an individual, not a company and as such the AABC logo should not be used on a company website or other marketing materials.

AABC Post-nominals

An architect who is registered with the AABC can use the post-nominal AABC or CAABC (depending on their category of accreditation). The use of post-nominals is encouraged as this clearly links accreditation to the individual, not the practice.

Use of an AABC signboard

Upon request, AABC signboards can be ordered and manufactured to record the use of an AABC accredited Architect as the conservation architect as part of the wider project team. The AABC signboard represents the individual architect who is included on the Register. As a not-for-profit organisation, AABC does not take a commission or fee from the sale of our signboards. All monies paid are for the production of the signboard only, charged by the sign maker directly.

AABC Certificate of Accreditation

Upon successful admission to the register a certificate proving the status of accreditation will be issued electronically. This can be reproduced for issue to clients or for a display to show membership.
